Job Summary

Working under the guidance of the Care Coordinator, the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) assesses, plans, implements, and evaluates nursing care for their work assignment in accordance with competency guidelines within the standards of practice as outlined by the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of BC (CLPNBC), current legislative scope of practice and in accordance with the established policies and procedures of George Derby Centre.

We are hiring permanent as well as casual for this role.

Responsibilities and Duties

- 1. Assesses, plans, implements and evaluates resident care needs including physiological, psychological, socio-cultural, and spiritual.
- 2. Provides direct resident care including administration of medications and treatment.
- 3. Reports problems and/or changes to the Registered Nurse or Care Coordinator.
- 4. Contributes to the development and modification of the individualized plan of care, by providing input into interdisciplinary care conferences, medication reviews and other meetings as required.
- 5. When required, performs admissions, discharges, and transfers of residents/patients.
- 6. Maintains paper and electronic documents for accuracy and relevancy, and ensures confidentiality is followed as per policies.
- 7. Supervises and provides direction to the Resident Care Aides, including reassignment of workload.
- 8. Provides and assists with personal care to residents as required.
- 9. Participates in continuous quality improvement, education sessions, resident care conferences, meetings, and committees.
- 10. All safety rules and safe work procedures are adhered to at all times.
- 11. Reports all hazards, incidents, near misses and workplace injuries to the manager immediately and in writing.
- 12. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Graduation from a recognized program for Practical Nurses or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience recognized by the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of British Columbia (CLPNBC).

Maintains Practicing Full Scope Licensure with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of British Columbia

(CLPNBC).

Maintains Valid First Aid and CPR "A".

Previous experience in a long term care facility is an asset.
